Train Passes

The InterRail Sweden Pass

Valid for Travel to
Oslo & Copenhagen

Get full access to all lines operated by SJ, the main railway company of Sweden, as well as many private railways in Sweden such as Veolia, Arlanda Express, Tagkompaniet and Merresor.

- Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively in 1st or second class.
- Stopovers allowed en-route.
- Children between the ages of 4 and 11 travel for half the Adult fare while children under 4 years of age travel for free.
- Special fares for Youth aged 12 to 25.
- InterRail Sweden Pass is also valid on direct Swedish Rail (SJ) trains to and from Copenhagen and Copenhagen Airport.
- The InterRail Sweden Pass is also valid on the Norwegian part of the journey in the direct border crossing day and night trains Stockholm-Oslo, Malmö-Oslo and Gothenburg-Oslo.

VALIDITY: 3, 4, 6 or 8 days in 1 month.

FARES: Adult, Child; 1st or 2nd Class - Youth; 2nd Class.

The InterRail Norway Pass

Get full access to all lines operated by NSB, the National State Railways of Norway in 2nd Class.

- Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively.
- Special fares are available for Youths between the ages of 12 and 25
- Children between the ages of 4 and 11 travel for half the adult fare while children under 4 travel for free (up to 2 children per traveling adult if seat reservations or supplement for sleeper is not required).
- The InterRail Norway Pass also qualifies you for additional discounts on the Flam Line and on several ferries.

VALIDITY: 3, 4, 6 or 8 days in 1 month.

FARES: Adult, Child; 1st or 2nd Class - Youth; 2nd Class.

The InterRail Finland Pass

The InterRail Finland Pass offers the easiest way to travel the rail network of Finland, from Helsinki to the Arctic Circle and anywhere in between.

- Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively in 1st or 2nd class.
- Children 4-11 years of age pay half the adult fare if the child is accompanied by a parent. Children under 4 travel free and do not require a ticket.

VALIDITY: 3, 4, 6 or 8 days in 1 month.

FARES: Adult, Child; 1st or 2nd Class – Youth; 2nd Class.



The InterRail Denmark Pass

The InterRail Denmark Pass gives you unlimited access to the entire Danish rail network. Travel the Danish countryside and delve into the rich culture that makes the country special.

- Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively in 1st or 2nd Class.
- Children 4 to 11 pay half the adult fare.
- A Youth pass is available for travellers under 26 years of age.

VALIDITY: 3, 4, 6 or 8 days in 1 month.

FARES: Adult, Child; 1st or 2nd Class - Youth; 2nd Class.

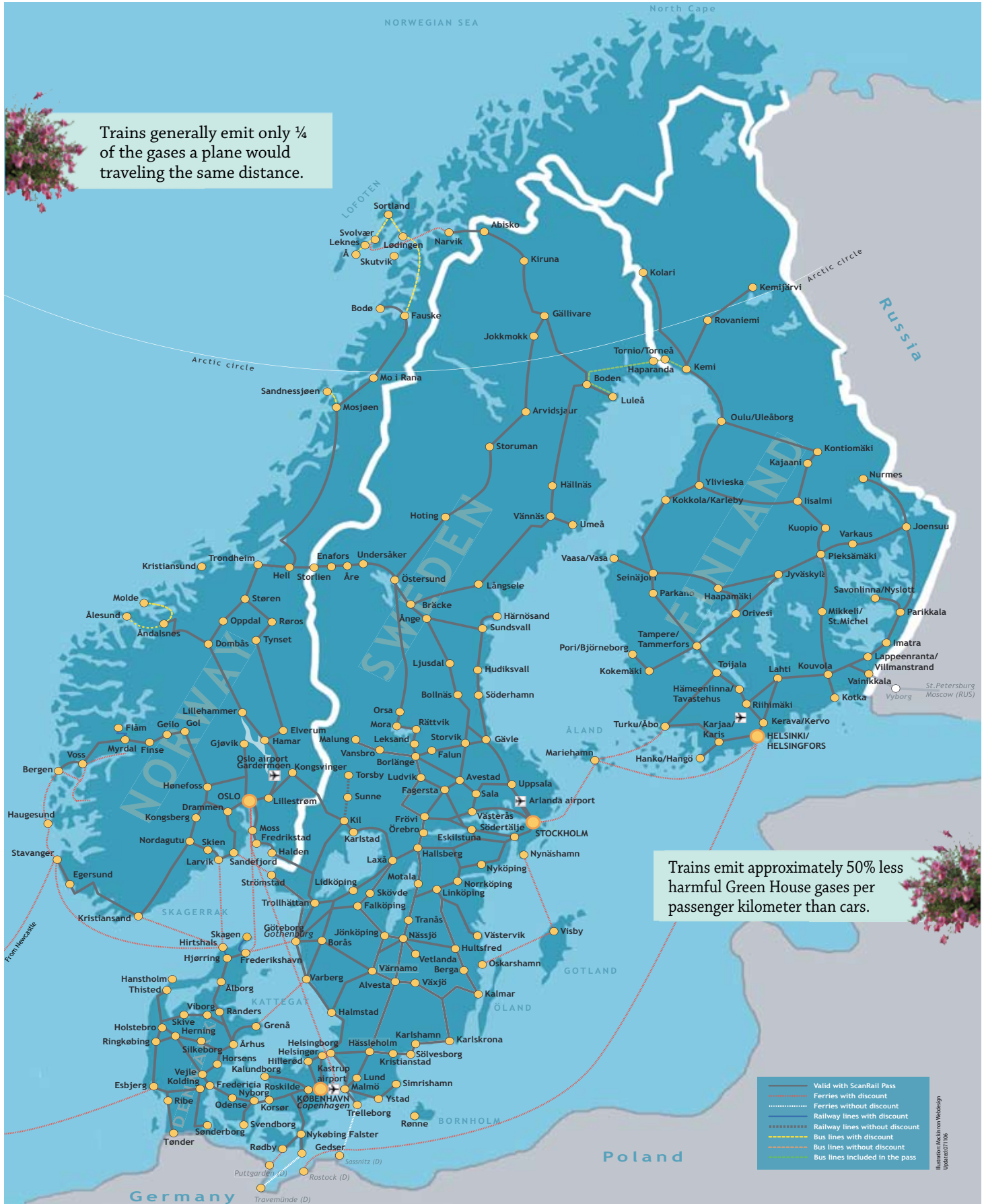

(Formerly The Royal Fjord Tour)

The longest (204km) and deepest (1309m) fjord in the world awaits you with this impressive train journey on the Flåm Railway line and boat journey on the Sognefjord through some of the most impressive and majestic views of the sea, mountains and the fjord.

- This tour is valid for travel between May 1st and September 30th.
- Optional direction of travel is permitted.
- Stopovers are permitted and strongly encouraged. A 1 to 3 day period is best to fully appreciate the tour.
- Reservations are not included. No reservation necessary on the Expressboat.
- Reservations are recommended on the region trains of the Bergen Railway line.
- Children between the ages of 4 and 15 pay half the adult fare. Children under 4 travel for free.

FARES: Adult, Child; 2nd Class.

The fjord cruise on the Hardanger fjord by boat then offers spectacular views of towering mountains and impressive waterfalls.

- Tour is available from June through August.
- Tour includes train, bus and boat transportation.
- Children between the ages of 4 to 15 pay a reduced fare. Children under 4 travel for free.
- Optional direction is available: Bergen-Voss-Ulvik-Eidfjord-Norheimsund-Bergen.
- Reservations are recommended on the region trains on the Bergen Railway line.
- The duration of the tour is best appreciated over a 1 to 3 day period.

FARES: Adult, Child; 2nd Class.
